
ABOUT US


The <u>National Association of Community Health Workers (NACHW)</u>, founded in April 2019 by Community Health Workers (CHWs) and their allies, is the national voice for CHWs across geography, race, ethnicity, language, sector, and lived experience. Our mission is to unite CHWs to support communities to achieve health, equity, and social justice. NACHW recognizes all CHWs, including Community Health Representatives from tribal nations (CHRs), Promotoras(es) de Salud, Peers, Outreach Workers, and over 95 other workforce <u>titles</u>.

Our values – self-determination and self-empowerment of our workforce; integrity of character; dignity and respect for every human being, social justice, and equity to ensure fair treatment, access, opportunity, and outcomes for all individuals and communities – guide our work. They are north stars we will use to support our members, foster partnerships, advocate nationally, develop strategic objectives, and assess our impact.

NACHW is led by an Executive Director who is also a CHW and enjoys governance from a national Board of Directors of predominately CHWs and allies with decades of research and practice expertise in CHW training and workforce development, community organizing, and engagement, intervention design, equity, and social justice advocacy, research, and policy leadership.

- Advocate for sustainable and equitable policies and funding that respect, protect and authentically partner with CHWs and CHW Networks and Associations (see our Document Resource <u>Center</u>, National CHW Policy <u>Platform</u>, 2nd Annual National CHW <u>Hill Day</u> and National CHW Awareness <u>Week</u>)
- Activate CHW leadership, capacity and vision during <u>COVID-19</u> and beyond

NACHW now has over 2,200 members who represent diverse languages, cultures, and geographies working in primary care, hospital, and behavioral health settings, health departments, health plans, and community-based organizations and realizing our core CHW roles to address health equity and the social determinants of health. They hail from all 50 states and a growing number of U.S. sovereign tribes and territories.

The Unity Conference has been a staple event for the CHW profession and we look forward to having you at the next in-person Unity Conference taking place in the summer of 2025!




